- The founder of the World Harvest Society of India (WHSI) is Tanyendra Mondal. He is based in Calcutta with his wife, Loyi and their three children.



- The founder of Outpouring Ministries (OPM) is Steve Harris. OPM was brought into existence in 1999 to raise support for the poor of our region. Steve and his wife Carol are based in Brisbane and currently travel to India once a year (for 4 weeks at a time) to assist Tanyendra and Loyi. Steve is planning to eventually spend up to three months annually in India assisting WHSI with the excellent work that they are doing.



- Together, Tanyendra and Steve are involved in programmes which benefit the local Indian communities on the states of West Bengal, Assam, Nagaland, Orissa, and Jharkhand.
- The main activities are childrens' programmes, feeding programmes, and Festivals of Prayer.

CHILDREN'S PROGRAMME



- The childrens' programme occurs once every 4 weeks in Krishnapur, which is an outlying area of Calcutta. Many of the children come from the Bangladesh refugee community which is located close to Krishnapur.

Some of the activities of the World Harvest Society's childrens' programmes include :-

- Feeding programme.
- Shoes and items for school are provided for the children as funds permit.
- We pray for children who are sick, and have seen some amazing results from that with many sicknesses completely healed.

Attendance at the monthly programme varies between 250-350 children.

We have recently been given four parcels of land – one in the Calcutta region, two in Nagaland, and one on the border of Nagaland and Assam. We are planning to build two schools for the Adivasi (tribal) children on two of those blocks of land.

We are currently looking at ways to provide sponsorship opportunities to help cover the educational and other basic needs (medical, food etc.) for these children.

FESTIVALS of PRAYER

Another activity that is run by Tanu and Steve is called the Festival of Prayer. These are held throughout north eastern and south eastern India. Hundreds of people gather together (typically between 300 and 700). We provide nutritious meals and we pray for the sick. People are nourished physically by the food, and at the same time there have been thousands of healing miracles, such as blind eyes opened, lame walking, deaf ears opened, heart conditions gone, and all kinds of sicknesses healed.



HOW CAN YOU BE INVOLVED?

(i) HELP TO DEVELOP LAND in KRISHNAPUR

- Land in the Krishnapur village, adjacent to the existing areas used by WHSI, has been donated to WHSI. It's about 120 - 150 sq.m.
- The land needs to be filled in to be usable, as it currently consists of a fairly large hole in the ground & is a little bit swampy.
- The cost to fill in the land is RS 200,000 or about \$AUD4500.00.
- Once the land is filled in, the Krishnapur facilities can be extended.
- Construction of new buildings = concrete slab, concrete corner columns, bamboo infill wall panels, tile rooves, insulated ceiling cavities. Cost TBA.



(ii) HELP TO BUILD A FRESH WATER WELL

- There is an existing village pump in Krishnapur. The water is suitable for washing, but not for drinking. A well for drinking water needs to be 150 metres deep. The cost is approximately 74,000 rupees, or about \$AUD1600.00.
- The new well will benefit the entire community.



(iii) SUPPORT THE PLANTING OF RUBBER TREES in NAGALAND

- Two tracts of land have been given to WHSI/OPM in Nagaland
 - One in particular is perfectly suited for growing rubber trees. It's a large tract of land, 12 "biga" which is approximately 17,250 sq.m.
 - The land can support 2,000 rubber trees. Rubber trees take 6 years to mature. After maturity, they will provide a continuous source of income to help sustain the childrens' programmes.
 - Rubber tree saplings cost 70 rupees each (about \$AUD1.50 each) so 2000 saplings have a total cost of about \$AUD3000.00.
 - Another piece of land, of similar size, has been set apart for a school in Nagaland. The intention is to provide English language and computer education for the Adivasi (indigenous tribal) children. Cost of establishing the school TBA.

(iv) DONATE NETBOOKS or LAPTOPS

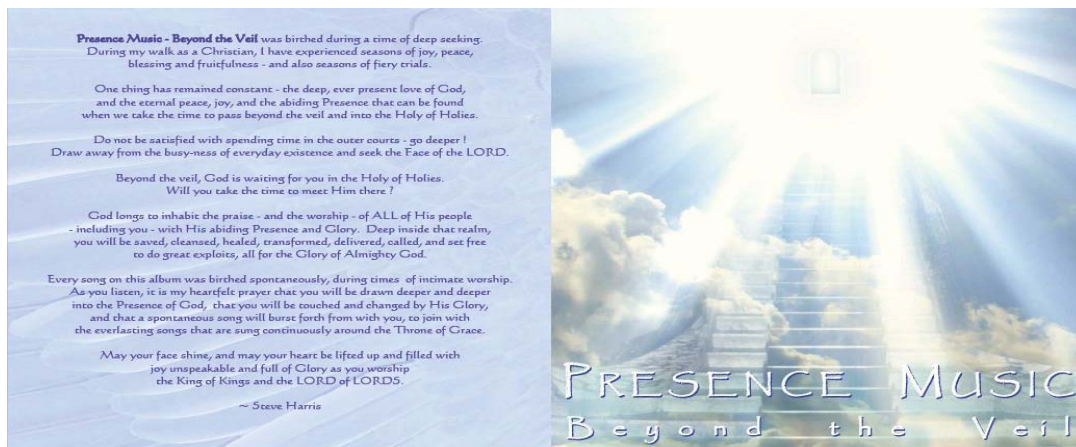
- We are in need of netbooks and laptops which can be used by the Adivasi children. The cost of a laptop is simply unattainable to the Adivasis.

(v) PURCHASE OUTPOURING MINISTRIES RESOURCES

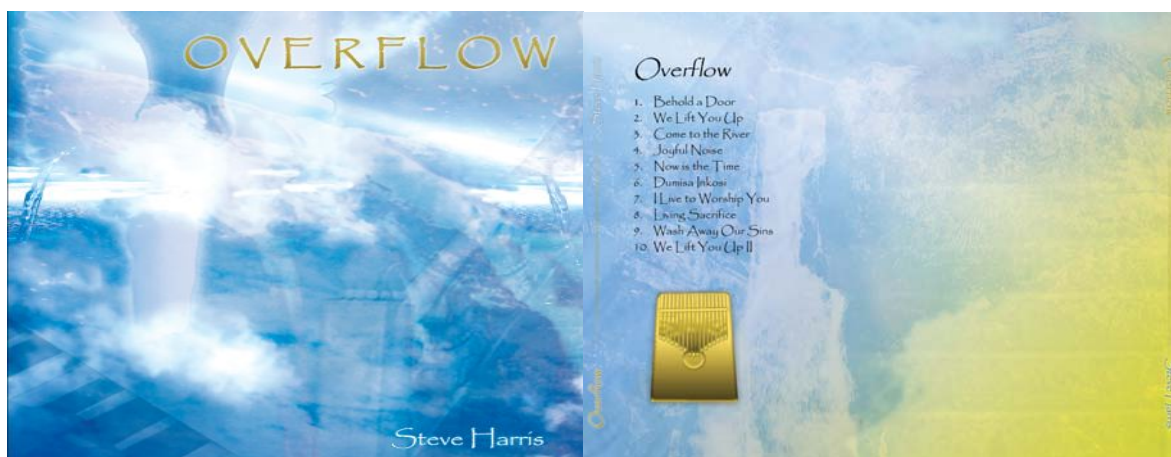
100% of sales of Outpouring Ministries resources is donated to support the World Harvest Society of India programmes.
